Tuition

All discounts and initial pay received at studio only - cannot accept cards for payment

Plan 1: Full Payment, Annual Tuition due 8/1, 10% discount

Plan 2: 2 payments, ½ tuition, with 5% discount: Payments due 8/1, & 1/1

Plan 3: Monthly Payment: Total classes divided over 10 payments.

There is no added charge when payments are made on time, however, **students are securing a class place & are obligated for the full term.** Initial Pay, 2 payments, Sept & June, due 8/1. If you do not continue for the term, you forfeit the June payment. Initial Payment must be made at the studio, check or cash. Final payment due before 5/1. Subsequent monthly payments are due the 1st of every month. Payments may be made online or at the studio. **Final payment due before 5/1. \$10 late fee on payments after the 5th.**

Adults may purchase a 10 class card for \$170, valid for 4 months, or pay \$18/class
Repertory fee is in addition to the class fee. \$125 for Jr. Rep, \$225 for Sr. Rep

The Ballet Academy opened in 1981 under the direction of Alison Miller. The Academy teaches the foundations of Classical Ballet based on the Royal Academy and Vaganova syllabi with emphasis on placement, technique and musicality. Classes in Repertory/Variations, and Stretch and Tone are also offered. The Ballet Academy is the resident company of The Performing Arts Repertory Company (performingarc.org). Level determination is based on prior training, age, and level of muscular development and coordination. Exceptions may be made at the Director/Instructor's discretion.

Ballet Youth Division: Pre-Ballet through Ballet V, Youth Jazz. The Pre-ballet is for children ages 3 to 4. Ballet I is for students 5 to 7 years of age. Ballet II to Ballet V often corresponds with the students' school level. Teens without prior ballet experience may join at the Ballet IV/V level, or Adult Basics.

Ballet Adult & Teens: Elementary I and II, Intermediate and Advanced are for students 12 and older. Adults and Teens may join any of the classes from Adult Basics to Intermediate/Advanced based on their training goals and experience. Teens without prior ballet experience may join at the Ballet IV/V level, or Adult Basics.

Youth/Teen Jazz: Classes will teach the fundamentals of jazz technique focusing on isolations, rhythm, jumps and turns. Higher levels will build on the fundamentals of jazz technique and dancers will also be introduced to Broadway, Fosse and contemporary jazz. *Placement at permission of instructor.* Dancers will explore connections among components through fun, challenging choreography and are offered the opportunity to perform at outreaches and theater productions.

Adult Jazz is for new or returning dancers. The class will introduce and build on jazz fundamentals, introduce different styles. Dancers will learn jazz choreography, jumps and turns and are also offered the opportunity to perform.

Stretch & Tone class is for anyone, with or without dance training, who is interested in improving range of motion, core strength and upper body strength. The class is a combination of myofascial stretching, dynamic stretching, pilates, and yoga, core exercises and upper body work with free weights.

Policy

- Students registering for a session are paying for classes offered. Closings as listed on the calendar are not included in tuition. It is the responsibility of the student to make up class(es) they miss within the term. Classes may be made up in advance.
- Students are expected to be prompt to class and properly attired.
- Tuition is non-refundable. Classes are non-transferable.
- Monthly payment Plan: **Students are securing a class place & are obligated for the full term. If you choose to not continue for the term you forfeit the last payment.** If you choose to re-enroll, space permitting, monthly payments for the 1st returning month and last month are required to secure your spot.
- Year-round registration is accepted. Students may be admitted to or change classes during the semester with Director/Instructor approval only.
- The studio does not follow the county for weather closings. Determination is made by 4 pm on weekdays and 9 am on Saturdays. Notification will be posted on our website, Facebook page, and an email will be sent out to those on the BA List.

Attire

All dancers must have hair secured from face. Female ballet dancers should wear a bun if possible.

Youth Division Ballet

Female: Leos, ballet pink tights, Shoes with ribbons, not elastic. Ballet II & up, elastic waistbands.
Males: white t-shirt, black tights, ballet slippers with elastic.

Jazz T-shirt or form fitting shirt, tight/pants/jazz pants black shoes preferred.
